

## DRESS CODE

- ✓ Minlaton District School encourages all staff, students and community members to have pride in themselves and their school, visible through the school dress code.
- ✓ This code has been developed in consultation with the school community and is endorsed by the Minlaton District School Governing Council.
- ✓ All students are expected to abide by the dress code in class, on the sports field and on excursions, unless otherwise directed by staff.
- ✓ The co-operation of parents is requested in the setting and maintaining of standards of dress, appearance and cleanliness by ensuring that students are dressed appropriately in school uniform.
- ✓ The MDS dress code promotes a positive image of our school, creating a sense of identity and unity
  among students and the community, supporting student safety through ease of identification and
  making sure students are dressed appropriately for all school activities.
- ✓ Freedom of movement, comfort, health and safety, climatic conditions, durability, practicality, expense, human rights and anti-discrimination considerations, other special circumstances have been considered in this dress code.

## **School Uniform:**

- ✓ MDS logo polo shirt (pictured)
- ✓ MDS logo jumper (pictured)
- ✓ MDS logo jacket (pictured)
- ✓ Navy blue shorts/skirts/skorts of mid-thigh minimum length.
- ✓ Navy blue and white checked uniform dress (pictured)
- ✓ Navy blue leggings/track pants/drill pants (excludes 'Active-wear')
- ✓ MDS logo broad brimmed hat- compulsory for Term 1 &4 (pictured)
- ✓ MDS logo beanie optional for Term 2&3 (pictured)
- ✓ Approved commemorative jumpers
- ✓ Footwear that is sturdy, safe and suitable for school activities
- ✓ PE Shirt (appropriate for physical activity)
- ✓ Approved culturally significant attire.
- ✓ Hair to be kept clean, neat, tidy and safe.
- ✓ Make-up/Jewellery to be kept to a minimum.
- ✓ Students are to abide by specific requirements for practical subjects (Science, PE, Tech, Art, Food & Hospitality etc).
- ✓ NOTE: Black or grey clothing is NOT allowed to be worn.
- ✓ If uniform requirements cannot be met by families, please contact your child's care group teacher.
