On iOS 12:

Settings, Screen Time, Turn on Screen Time



Content & Privacy Restrictions, Enter a four-digit pin., Re-enter the four-digit pin.



Now you can choose what type of content to block, including in-app purchases, adult websites, location sharing, apps, time restrictions, and heaps more. (its very comprehensive)



Restrictions for Android:

- 1. On the device you want parental controls on, open the Play Store app \triangleright .
- 2. In the top left corner, tap Menu \equiv > Settings > Parental controls.
- 3. Turn "Parental controls" On.
- 4. Create a PIN. This prevents people who don't know the PIN from changing your parental control settings. If you're setting up parental controls on your child's device, choose a PIN they don't already know.
- 5. Tap the type of content you want to filter.
- 6. Choose how to filter or restrict access.
